### The Cantor's Corner

The commentator Sfat Emet explains that Hanukkah candles should be lit in a doorway, for the doorway represents an opening to our future. It is, the Sfat Emet suggests, an opportunity for new beginnings. After all, the word Hanukkah itself is all about that: the Maccabees rededicated the Holy Temple and the word Hanukkah comes from the word to rededicate. Interestingly

enough, that word is related to the root H-n-ch that means to educate. Therefore, let's open the door to our future, by dedicating ourselves to our rich traditions and culture through education. Just a little learning goes a long way—in the words of our Sages, "God says 'Give me an opening the size of a needle with thread in it and I will give you a huge opening to come through." Doorways indeed.

Dedication through education only happens if one actually attends a lecture, a class, read a book, even watched a Jewish TV program of some sort. In short, if you're not educating yourself you're not dedicating yourself to a Jewish future at all. This, as I see it, is the single greatest fault of most Jewish communities. We get mediocre Sunday School educations in Judaism, think it's a bunch of nonsensical children's stories, and dismiss it. This is foolish. I would not have dedicated my life to Judaism if it were nothing but Bubbeh Mayses.

An entire generation of young people in this country those so-called Millennials/Generation Z—are frighteningly uninformed as to the real facts in the Israeli-Arab conflict. They go to college and because they are ignorant, they are easily swayed by well-funded anti-Israel groups. Those kids learn Bubbe Mayses alright. Then there is the rest of the American public of that generation who don't know that six million of our people were killed in the Holocaust. Indeed, some 10% of them did not even know the word 'Holocaust' was at all! Less than 50% of Americans understand that Hitler came to power in a democratically held legitimate election. How frightening is that?

As you all know, I will be leaving Altoona next summer. It has been a great four years of learning for me and has made me a far greater clergyman than I was when I came here. Nevertheless, I must warn you: no matter who your spiritual leader is, if you do not dedicate yourselves to the synagogue by coming to our programs, coming to make a minyan, coming to an online learning session, there is no way he/she can ever be successful here. Though the synagogue is financially secure and that is a great blessing (as well as a rarity), Agudath Achim is dangerously close to having a building that sits empty even on a Shabbos morning. Minyans are fewer and fewer. Those who do come are frustrated—why should they come if no one else does?

Our doorway here at Agudath Achim is open to a great Jewish future, but only if you walk through it.


